



JUNIOR ICEMEN 10 & UNDER

At the 10-and-Under level, coaches should focus on the following age-appropriate concepts and skills so that players enjoy the experience and develop both as hockey players and as young kids.

Age Group: 2012, 2013 | **Teams:** 10UA1

Start Date: The week of August 15th | End Date: End of February

Roster: 12-14 skaters, 1-2 goalies, equal playing time

Focus Points: Fun, Engagement, Active Practices, Age-Appropriate Training (includes skills and concepts), Basic hockey knowledge.

Icemen Experience: Each player will receive 2 tickets per season to preselected Icemen games. Players will also be provided with unique event experiences with the Icemen.

Game Rinks: Games are played throughout the state of Florida on most weekends.

Program: 3 On Ice practices and 2 off Ice practices weekly

Curriculum: All age groups follow a comprehensive 25-week on and off-ice curriculum focusing on age-appropriate training and proper player development guidelines. This will ensure all players have the opportunity to reach their full potential in a fun, challenging and positive learning environment.

Practice Focus

- 1. Individual skill improvement (hockey skills, activities, and games) 65%
- 2. Hockey sense (teaching of concepts through small area games) 25%
- 3. Systems (team-play training) 10%

- Must be predominantly navy gloves (no conflicting colors)
